Compete for the right to represent District 2 in the North American Finals, to be held at the Spring NABC in Memphis, TN - March 2019

FLIGHTS: A: Open B: 0 - 2500 MPs C: Non-Life Masters with < 500 MPs

The top 3 pairs in Flight A at the District level will qualify for the National Final.
The top 4 pairs in Flights B & C at the District level will qualify for the National Final.

ACBL awards – Per Flight: (conditional on participation in Memphis)

First Place - \$700 per person

Second Place - \$400 per person + District 2 top-up

This is a two-session multi-site District Final

Scores will be match pointed against results from Toronto and Winnipeg

- To be eligible for the District Final, players must have a club-level qualification and be ACBL members in good standing – New Partnerships may be formed at the District Level
- Players **are asked to pre-register** by Wednesday, Oct. 24, 2017
- A minimum of 5 tables is required to hold each event
 - In the event that there are insufficient entries in any flight affected pairs will be notified in time to register at another site (Toronto or Winnipeg)

DISTRICT 2 CONDITIONS OF CONTEST

- Flight A:** Open to all players
Flight B: Players with < 2500 MPs as of May 6, 2018.
Flight C: Non-Life Masters with < 500 MPs as of May 6, 2018.

District Finals will be multi-site

- 1) ACBL Conditions of Contest are part of District 2 Conditions of Contest.
- 2) Clubs may hold up to two (2) club qualifying games in each of the three months (June, July, August) for each weekly sanctioned session held that month. This applies to each flight.
- 3) If no clubs in a particular Unit hold club level qualifying games, then the Unit must hold a club level qualifying game.
- 4) Club Managers must submit a list of all qualifiers from any club level qualifying game to the District Co-ordinator after the club-qualifying period ends (Aug 31, 2018). ACBLScore will produce this list.
- 5) Any Unit may hold a Unit Final, if it so desires.
The results of this Unit Final will have no bearing on which pairs may participate in the District Final.
- 6) Any Unit wishing to hold a District Final must inform the District Co-ordinator of their intentions by Sept 15, 2018. A minimum of 5 tables are required to run an event in any Flight.
- 7) Participants in the District Final must be paid-up ACBL members, and hold a current Club Level Qualification.
- 8) New partnerships may be formed at the District level.
- 9) Monetary awards for the National Final are determined by the ACBL (conditional on participation in Memphis)
ACBL covers the entry fees for the National Final.
District 2 may choose to top up any award, in \$CAN, to match that of any higher placed participants.
- 10) District Overall Winners will be determined **after combined matchpointing** across all participating sites.

If there are 3 or more participating sites in a given Flight, the placings and monetary awards will be determined according to the overall finish.

For flights with only 2 locations...if one location (A) has at least a 2:1 ratio of tables over location (B),
District qualification spots will be determined as follows:

- 1: Highest overall
2. Highest overall at the other site (with a \$\$ top up)
3. 2nd highest overall at location A

If there is not a 2:1 ratio between the 2 sites, then the qualification spots will be determined as follows:

- 1: Highest overall
2. Highest overall at the other site (with a \$\$ top up)
3. Next highest across both sites

The 2018-19 District Finals will be a 2-session event, and will be held on Sunday, October 28, 2018.
